# Well-Known TCP Port Numbers

In <u>TCP/IP</u> and <u>UDP</u> networks, a port is an endpoint to a <u>logical</u> connection and the way a client program specifies a specific server program on a computer in a network. Some ports have numbers that are preassigned to them by the <u>IANA</u>, and these are known as well-known ports (specified in <u>RFC</u> 1700). Port numbers range from 0 to 65536, but only ports numbers 0 to 1024 are reserved for privileged services and designated as well-known ports. This list of well-known port numbers specifies the port used by the server process as its contact port.
